Year 6 SATs Tests

Parents and Carers are reminded that all year 6 pupils will be taking their SATs tests next week. Borough Market: Young Marketeers

Last Tuesday 3 children were selected to take part in training for Young Marketeers on behalf of the charity Fairshare. The children, joined by 9 other schools, were taught how to plant seeds and plant out in pots to produce good seedlings. They then created pots from newspaper in which they planted bean seeds. The second session took them around Borough Market to discover what makes a good trader in the market. They looked at signs, presentation of stalls and had a go at making this on a stall. Our children were particularly well behaved and gained valuable skills.

The aim is to grow vegetables at school to sell at the market and give the proceeds to Fairshare. For this we are looking for a small group of children in Years 2 & 3 to take part in an afterschool gardening club on Thursdays. **Is your child interested? See Ms Banton**

Year 5: Royal Observatory:

I1 and I2 visited the Royal Observatory last week. It linked to their current science topic which is Earth and Space. They went into the planetarium for an exploration through space, they looked at rocky planets, gas planets, stars, and much more. They were able to look at our galaxy and find out what exactly is in it! They discovered a lot in space and explored even further once the show was over. Our teachers were also complimented on the excellent behaviour, good focus and questioning by our children.
